#### **Overview**

Adele Gardner (they/them, Mx.) has forty published illustrations (watercolor, colored pencil, pen and ink, pencil, linocut, silkscreen, photography, and more) in small press publications (four of them later reprinted), including twelve as cover art. As of March 2024, seventeen different pieces have shown in exhibitions (four of them showed in two different exhibitions, and one showed in three), with one earning entry into the statewide Virginia Artists Juried Exhibition and one winning honorable mention at the Virginia Peninsula Community College Annual Student Juried Art Exhibition & Film Festival. Gardner is currently focusing primarily on watercolors and colored pencils to illustrate various book projects (https://www.scbwi.org/members/adele-gardner). ### <u>A note on bylines.</u>

I am now primarily using my middle name, <u>Adele Gardner</u> (they/them, Mx.), in tribute to my namesake, my father and mentor, Del (<u>Delbert R. Gardner</u>, for whom I serve as literary executor). Past works have appeared under variations of my legal name (Carolyn Adele Gardner, C. A. Gardner, Carolyn A. Gardner), my previous nickname (Lyn C. A. Gardner, Lyn Gardner), my SCA name (Deirdre Ní Fionnula), or C. A. LeSabre. Work is also currently being published under the separate byline <u>Max Jason Peterson</u>. Max has a separate website with additional bibliographies linked through the Gardner Castle portal.
